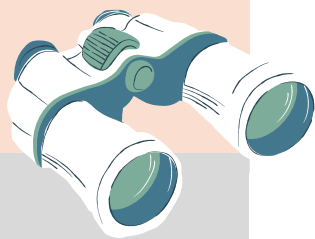




TRAVEL GUIDE ABOUT QUEENS

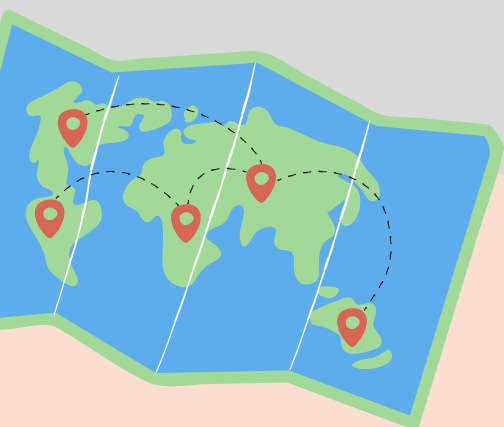
QUEENS THEATRE

Queens Theatre is the premier performing center in the borough of Queens.
